### Minutes of Meeting

#### Souris River Joint Water Resource Board

Thursday, August 2, 2018

A regular meeting of the board of directors of the Souris River Joint Water Resource Board was called to order by Chairman David Ashley at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 2, 2018, in the Community Room of the Minot Auditorium, in the City of Minot, North Dakota. Joint Board members attending the meeting were David Ashley, Dan Jonasson, Clif Issendorf, Roger Sauer and Tom Klein. A roster of those in attendance is attached as **Attachment A**. Chairman David Ashley called the meeting to order and announced that a quorum was present.

The Joint Board discussed the proposed Agenda for the meeting.

Roger Sauer moved to approve the agenda. Dan Jonasson seconded the motion. The motion passed without opposition.

The draft Minutes from the July 10, 2018 meeting were discussed.

Dan Jonasson made a motion to approve the Minutes from the July 10 meeting. Roger Sauer seconded the motion. The motion passed without opposition.

The Joint Board discussed the Budget Report included in the August Board Packet. Ryan Ackerman handed out an updated Budget Report, attached as **Attachment B**.

Roger Sauer moved to approve the updated Budget Report. Clif Issendorf seconded the motion. The motion passed without opposition.

The Joint Board discussed the 2019 Draft Preliminary Budget, which was presented to the Joint Board. The 2019 Draft Preliminary Budget is attached as **Attachment C**. A discussion regarding the process for the Joint Board requesting its levy ensued.

Tom Klein moved to approve the 2019 Draft Preliminary Budget. Roger Sauer seconded the motion. The motion passed without opposition.

The Joint Board discussed bills. Bills totaling \$3,396,061.15 were presented to the Joint Board. A revised bill summary spreadsheet was provided to the Joint Board, which is attached as **Attachment D**. It was noted that two bills were not included in the August Board Packet, one for Margaret Olson Scouton and Mars Enterprises, and one for Border States Electric. The bill for Border States Electric in the amount of \$7,486.76 is attached as **Attachment E**.

Tom Klein made a motion to approve the bills in the amount of \$3,396,061.15. Roger Sauer seconded the motion. The motion passed without opposition.

Jerry Bents from Houston provided the Joint Board with a presentation on Phase MI-1 construction, which included a digital slide show and drone video. Jerry Bents also provided an update to the Joint Board regarding the status of MI-5 design.

Jason Westbrock from Barr Engineering provided the Joint Board with an update for Phase MI-2/3 construction, which included a drone video. Following the update, the Joint Board discussed proposed change orders to the Phase MI-2/3 construction contract. The first change order was priced at \$20,681.45, for the construction of stormwater pipe to replace a damaged 8" stormwater pipe that was discovered during construction. The second change order was priced at \$45,423.97, for new drainage improvements adjacent to the levy near the Souris River Golf Course. This drainage improvement is considered a "betterment," therefore the cost of this change order is eligible as a credit against the Joint Board's obligations to the Park District for land acquisition costs for the Project.

Dan Jonasson moved to approve the two change orders described by Ryan Ackerman. Roger Sauer seconded the motion. A discussion ensued. Dan Jonasson indicated that he had reviewed the change orders in detail prior to the meeting, and indicated that the improvements were necessary. A roll call vote was held. The motion passed without opposition.

Jason Westbrock provided the Joint Board with an update on Phase BU-1 and Phase BU-1A design.

Emily Huettl provided the Joint Board with an update on the StARR Program. A few revised offers have been made to StARR participants. Demolition contractors have mobilized and are beginning work, and the first StARR ring dike is possibly moving forward. The recent outreach to landowners has resulted in several new interested potential applicants. It was discussed that ring dikes within the 100 year flood plain were not eligible because of flood insurance requirements for those properties. Emily Huettl directed the Joint Board's attention to an Advertisement for Bids located at page 176 of the August Board Packet.

Tom Klein moved to approve the Advertisement for Bids. Roger Sauer seconded the motion. The motion passed without opposition.

The next item of discussion was U.S. Army Corps Engineers (USACE) Feasibility Study. Ryan Ackerman reported that Major General Richard Kaiser visited the Mouse River basin on July 17, 2018. Ryan Ackerman reported that Major General Kaiser concurred with the Project's eligibility for federal involvement. The goal at this point is to be included in the pending federal WRDA bill.

Ryan Ackerman provided the Joint Board with an update on future meetings, and directed the Joint Board's attention to a list of upcoming meetings included in the Board Packet. Ryan Ackerman reported that the Joint Board would be hosting the Water Topics Overview Committee Meeting and Tour on August 13 and 14, starting at 1:00 p.m. at the Grand Hotel.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
