The Minot Area Chamber of Commerce enthusiastically supports the joint application of the City of Minot and the Souris River Joint Board for the 2019 BUILD Transportation Grant related to the 3rd Street Northeast Bridge Reconstruction and Rail Raise project in Minot, North Dakota. This project is a critical component of a multi-jurisdictional effort to replace outdated infrastructure while increasing the resiliency of the community and industry to flooding.
